

Clarington's Parks, Recreation and Culture Implementation Plan

Since the adoption of Clarington's Parks, Recreation and Culture Master Plan (PRCMP) in 2024, significant progress has been made on many of its 113 recommendations. Council has now endorsed an implementation plan and financing strategy to advance several short-term priorities between 2024 and 2028 — with many already underway!

Completed To Date

- ✓ [Newcastle Community Park](#): Tennis/pickleball courts, tournament-grade baseball diamond, and skate park.
- ✓ [Middle Park](#) softball diamond, splash pad and playground.
- ✓ Brookhill Parkette, Bruce Cameron Park, and [Rose Parkette](#).
- ✓ Nine parks reconstructed, including enlarged play pods, new playground equipment, benches, waste receptacles and reconstructed park pathways.
- ✓ Courtice [outdoor refrigerated skating rink](#).
- ✓ Outdoor accessible fitness area, 2 lit tennis courts, and multi-skills court at [South Courtice Arena](#).
- ✓ Baseball lighting replacement at Orono Park.
- ✓ [Solina Park](#) tennis courts rebuilt.
- ✓ CLMA [Book Locker](#) in Hampton.



In the Works



South Bowmanville Recreation Centre: indoor aquatic centre, fitness studio, double gym, multi-purpose spaces, indoor turf field, community park and book locker.



Renewed **Waterfront Strategy.**



500m of trails in **Bowmanville municipal park** (former Zoo lands).



4 splashpad and 6 park rebuilds, design of 3 new neighbourhood parks in new communities, Newcastle Waterfront Park design.



Sponsorship plan to reduce barriers and increase access to municipal programming.



New outdoor fitness equipment in high traffic areas.



Identify site for a full-size cricket field.



Studies to update Visual Arts Centre and identify need for indoor performing arts venue.



Park land for new recreational amenities will be secured through development approvals. As new communities across Clarington are developed, more recreation will follow, including new tennis courts, pickleball courts, multi-use courts, and splash pads.



Two new outdoor refrigerated skating pads in Bowmanville and Newcastle.
